COMMUNITY WORKER Job Outline and responsibilities

Job Outline

This post will report to the Senior Leader of KC. They will work in collaboration with the Kids worker. It is essential for them to be huddled by the senior leader and would be desirable for them to attend key leader weekends and evenings.

Responsibilities

1. Coordinate, strengthen and encourage the existing Kings kids team. Develop the missional opportunities for Kings Kids and ensure a consistent and loving, safe environment in which the families of the community can come.
2. To develop the Kings Kids team to multiply onto at least one other day or session.
3. To pioneer a new project into the elderly generation.

This would require gaining God led vision, building team, potentially bidding for resources, connecting and linking with existing agencies in the city, communicating the launch of the project using multiple communication strategies, and leading the team each week. The leadership of the church would hope that this project would develop a space for the elderly where they can build community and reduce isolation.
